#### WELLBOURNE


Wellbourne is a unique blend of greys and blues with a semi-metallic appearance which will compliment front facades and enhance architectural features.

### LONSDALE


Lonsdale is a classic, timeless and handcrafted clay brick with a heavily textured appearance and deep charcoal tones.






### CIRRUS


With a fresh and crisp balance of light grey tones, Cirrus will add sophistication and elegance to both traditional and modern homes.

Guaranteed to stand out from the crowd, Ciena is a stunning earthy brick with undertones of red and orange that will add a sophisticated tone to elevate any home.




Classic elegance at its best, the beige and deep brown tones of Buckram will bring a modern and urbane look to any home.






### COPPERSTONE

Copperstone's traditional red tones, hearting and rough-hewn texture will imbue your home with a stunning and natural feel.








### VINTAGE RED (TUMBLED)



#### **MORTAR JOINTS**

Selkirk brick range is recommended to be used with a rolled mortar joint.



#### **MORTAR COLOURS**

Different combinations of sand and cement can have a significant impact on mortar colour, and contribute to the overall look of the final brickwork. Changing the mortar colour from white, or natural to black can have a dramatic effect.

Talk to your Builder or Bricklayer for more information regarding the various mortar colours available.





#### TECHNICAL INFORMATION

#### **BLENDING AND CLEANING**

It is essential that all bricks be blended carefully by your bricklayer to ensure an even colour distribution. If done correctly blending will provide a consistent colour and texture. Your bricklayer is responsible for the correct blending of your bricks. Brick cleaning is an integral part of finalising the look of your new home and should only be undertaken by a qualified and/or accredited brick cleaner. If not done correctly and using the right methods (high pressure water or Hydrochloric Acid) then the chemicals and/or high water pressure used can easily damage your bricks. Different bricks and textures will often need different cleaning methods.

Brick layers and cleaners checklists are available from our website www.selkirk.com. au/technical. All checklists are in accordance with Think Brick recommendations.

#### TRANSPORT AND DELIVERY

Bricks may be moved several times prior to being delivered to your site. During this handling, chipping may occur. This does not affect the performance of the brick. If there are any concerns please ask your builder / bricklayer to contact their Selkirk representative to organise a site meeting prior to laying. Selkirk Pty Ltd is unable to accept liability for costs incurred as a result of failure or delay in delivery of the product. #### NATURAL VARIATIONS IN CLAY

When considering your design please remember that Selkirk clay bricks are manufactured using natural clays and minerals and fired at extremely high temperatures. The natural variations in both the clay and firing process often means textures, size and colour including flashing will vary from batch to batch, therefore colour variation between manufacturing runs is possible.

#### WARRANTY

The brick colours shown in this brochure are an indication only and may be different from the actual product. It is always a good idea to view the product through your builder or agent and confirm availability of the selected brick prior to making your selection. Your builder/bricklayer should check the delivered packs as soon as possible after delivery. All warranty claims must be made prior to the product being laid.

#### PREPARING DELIVERY

The final step in ensuring that Selkirk provides you with an outstanding product and quality service is to ensure that your product makes it to site in a timely, safe and responsible manner. Answering these simple questions can ensure delivery is a smooth process. After all, the sooner the products arrive, the sooner your project can commence!

#### WHEN SHOULD I ORGANISE THE DELIVERY OF MY PRODUCT?

We recommend that you arrange your delivery to arrive at least 48 hours prior to the commencement of work. Delivering your product the same day as work starts will result in loss of time. We advise that, where possible, you take your entire order in a single delivery.

#### IS MY SITE ACCESSIBLE?

Delivery trucks are large – 15 metres long, 2.5 metres wide and 4 metres high – and require appropriate safe parking in close proximity to your site. All terrain forklifts used to place building products on site require at least 2.5 metres clear width and, 3.0 metres clearance height. Therefore, our Customer Service team needs to know if there are any obstacles or restrictions that may cause difficulties in accessing your site.

If drivers are to operate equipment on busy roadways, clear ways, in close proximity to schools/crossings, double lined roadways etc, it is your responsibility to provide traffic control in order to maintain a safe working environment. (Please note: traffic control persons must be trained and hold a current certificate of competency).

### CAN MY SITE SUSTAIN THE WEIGHT OF PRODUCT AND MACHINERY DURING DELIVERY?

A forklift carrying bricks or pavers can weigh around 7 tonne. It is your responsibility to ensure that any surface the forklift traverses over is capable of sustaining this weight. Selkirk will not be liable for any damage caused to underground services.

#### IS MY SITE SAFE ENOUGH?

Please ensure that children are well out of the way and pets are restrained. Drivers are well trained and will do their best to place your product where required, but the driver has the final say when it comes to personal risk or possible site damage.

#### IS THERE AN EASIER WAY TO GO ABOUT THINGS?

If you are building a large house that takes up most of the block, you may consider taking delivery of the bricks for the rear of the house prior to the excavation of the site and the pouring of the slab. This will help your bricklayer avoid damage to the slab or the possibility of the driver being unable to place your product where you require it.
